Waiver for Participation

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

I hereby acknowledge that my minor child or I have voluntarily chosen to participate in the Kittitas County Chamber of Commerce Bikes and Brews Bike Ride (hereinafter called “Activity”) as stated below.

I understand the risks involved with my participation in the Activity. I recognize that the Activity involves the risk of injury and I agree to accept any and all risks associated with it, including but not limited to property damage or loss, minor bodily injury, severe bodily injury, and death. Furthermore, I recognize that participation in the Activity involves risks incidental thereto, including but not limited to, physical exertion for which I am not prepared, forces of nature, travel on bicycle, terrorism, breakdown of equipment, accident or illness without access to means of rapid evacuation or availability of medical supplies, limited availability of medical assistance, and the possible reckless conduct of other participants. I am voluntarily participating in the Activity with the knowledge of the risks involved and hereby agree to accept any and all inherent risks of property damage, bodily injury, and death.

I certify that my minor child or I am physically capable of participating in the Activity and I know of no medical or health reason which would prevent my minor child or me from participating safely.

In consideration of my minor child’s or my participation in the Activity and to the fullest extent permitted by law, I agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Kittitas County Chamber of Commerce, City of Roslyn, Ride Roslyn, the Coal Mines Trail Commission and their directors, volunteers, agents, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the Activity from and against all claims arising out of or resulting from my minor child’s or my participation in the Activity that may be made by me, my family, estate, heirs or assigns. “Claim” as used in this agreement means any financial loss, claim, suit, action, damage or expense, including but not limited to attorney’s fees, attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or injury to or destruction of tangible property including loss of use resulting there from.

I agree to assume all the foregoing risks and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability and death.

I give permission for Kittitas County Chamber of Commerce staff to seek emergency medical services for my minor child or myself should we become injured or ill with the understanding that I will assume full responsible for any and all medical expenses which may be incurred as a result of an accident or illness.

I further understand that this assumption of risk and hold harmless is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Washington and that if any portion hereof is held invalid, I agree that the balance shall, notwithstanding continue in full legal force and effect.

THE WHAT...

The 2nd Annual Bikes and Brews returns to welcome bike enthusiasts to the unique recreational opportunities of the Upper Kittitas. The event will be held along with the Mountain Ale Festival in Roslyn, WA as a way to start the day in the beautiful Upper Kittitas County communities

THE WHEN...

The Bikes and Brews bike ride will be held on Saturday, October 13, 2018 and will start at 11:00 AM with the Family Ride and 11:45 AM for the Rugged Ride. All riders must leave at the time of the event. Registration will open at 10:30 AM at the Roslyn Yard

THE WHERE...

Registration and check in for the Bikes and Brews bike ride will be at the Roslyn Yard in Roslyn, Washington. This location is a few blocks from the head of the trails.

FAMILY RIDE: Registration for the Family Ride is available online and in person the morning of the ride. Fees for the family ride are non-refundable as the ride will occur rain or shine. This ride features fairly flat services with a gradual incline on the Coal Mines Trail, a gravel recreation trail. **This Ride starts at 11:00 AM**

RUGGED RIDE: The Rugged Ride registration will be available online and in person. However, this ride is **limited to 12 riders**. Riders must be intermediate to professionally skilled to participate. Registration will be refunded if the ride is cancelled due to severe trail conditions. *Children 16 and under are not allowed in this ride.* The bike ride trail is subject to change based on forest trail closures and trail conditions. **This Ride starts at 11:45 AM**

Pre-registrants who sign up online can bring their paperwork with them the morning of the ride. We will have blank forms available for all riders to ensure all necessary paperwork is completed.

THE HOWS...

Both rides will be guided rides by experienced bike riders from Ride Roslyn.

To participate, attendees must sign all appropriate paperwork and pay an entrance fee as stated on page five of this packet. All riders under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Once finished with the ride, riders can enjoy themselves in the beautiful city of Roslyn, Washington, and join us at the Roslyn Mountain Ale Festival from 1-5pm. Must be 21 or older to attend the Mountain Ale Festival.

PARKING...

Parking for bike ride participants is located on Pennsylvania Ave in Roslyn, WA or near the trail head of the Coal Mines Trail.



RULES...PLEASE READ

1. All riders must register and pay the entry fee prior to participating
2. All riders will read and sign the Acknowledgement of Risk and Hold Harmless Agreement and Rules and Regulations form prior to the event. Riders 18 years and younger will have a parent/guardian sign the agreements.
3. All riders will read and abide by the Rules of the Road for Washington State Bicyclists.
4. All riders will abide by the ride guides while on the trail and participating in the ride.
5. All riders will wear approved helmets for this event.
6. All riders will follow the course as outlined and marked for the Bikes and Brews Ride
7. All riders agree to follow all directions of bike guides.
8. All participants agree to be photographed or filmed during the event.
9. There are no refunds if the application is cancelled.
10. The package ticket deal is only available with purchase of a Mountain Ale Festival ticket.
If registering for the bike ride morning of the event, proof of ticket purchase must be shown to get the package ticket deal.
11. Registering for the Bikes & Brews bike ride does not include entry to the Roslyn Mountain Ale Festival.
12. You will be riding through forest land. Please remember, PACK IT IN, PACK IT OUT.
Please help us keep our forests clean for us all to enjoy.
